Dia Anagnostou is Associate Professor of Comparative Politics and International Governance, in the Department of Public Administration at Panteion University of Social Sciences, and Senior Research Fellow at the Hellenic Foundation of European and Foreign Policy (ELIAMEP) in Athens (from September 2004 until present). Anagnostou has held research positions at Princeton University (1999-2000), at the European University Institute in Florence (2000-2001; 2010-2012), and at the University of Cyprus (2020-2022), and she also teaches at the College of Europe in Bruges. As an academic and social scientist, Anagnostou has longstanding and wide-ranging experience on research and teaching human rights in Europe. It encompasses in-depth knowledge of the ECHR regime, and strong familiarity with the EU fundamental rights framework. From an interdisciplinary perspective at the crossroads of law and political science, her research has focused on the influence that courts, international/EU law and civil society exert in

advancing rights, in areas such as gender equality, minorities, migrants and vulnerable groups. Over the past fifteen years, she has been coordinator or partner in several research projects funded by the European Commission's Framework Programs. Anagnostou is a member of the National Council for Gender Equality in Greece, Vice President of the Gender Equality Committee at Panteion University, and formerly, a national expert in the Standing Working Group on Gender in Research and Innovation in the ERA. She is co-author and editor of four books, and fifty articles and book chapters. Her most recent publication is the monograph *The European Convention of Human Rights Regime – Reform of Immigration and Minority Policies from Afar* (Routledge, 2023).
