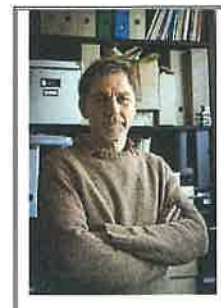

Paul De Hert is a Full Professor and Co-director of the Fundamental Rights Research Centre (FRC) at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB), Belgium, and Associated Professor at Tilburg University (TILT), Netherlands. After his PhD on surveillance and law, he worked as a senior researcher at the Belgium Data Protection Authority, before moving full time to the academia. Throughout his career, De Hert has written extensively on privacy and technology, human rights and criminal law. In 2018 he contributed to the revision of the FRA Handbook on European data protection law.

Over the years he worked and taught at several universities (Leiden, Tilburg, Brussels). His broad teaching experience comprises courses on 'Human Rights', 'Legal theory', 'Historical constitutionalism' and 'Constitutional criminal law'. Currently, 'Criminal Law', and 'International and European Criminal Law' and 'Privacy and Data Protection'.
