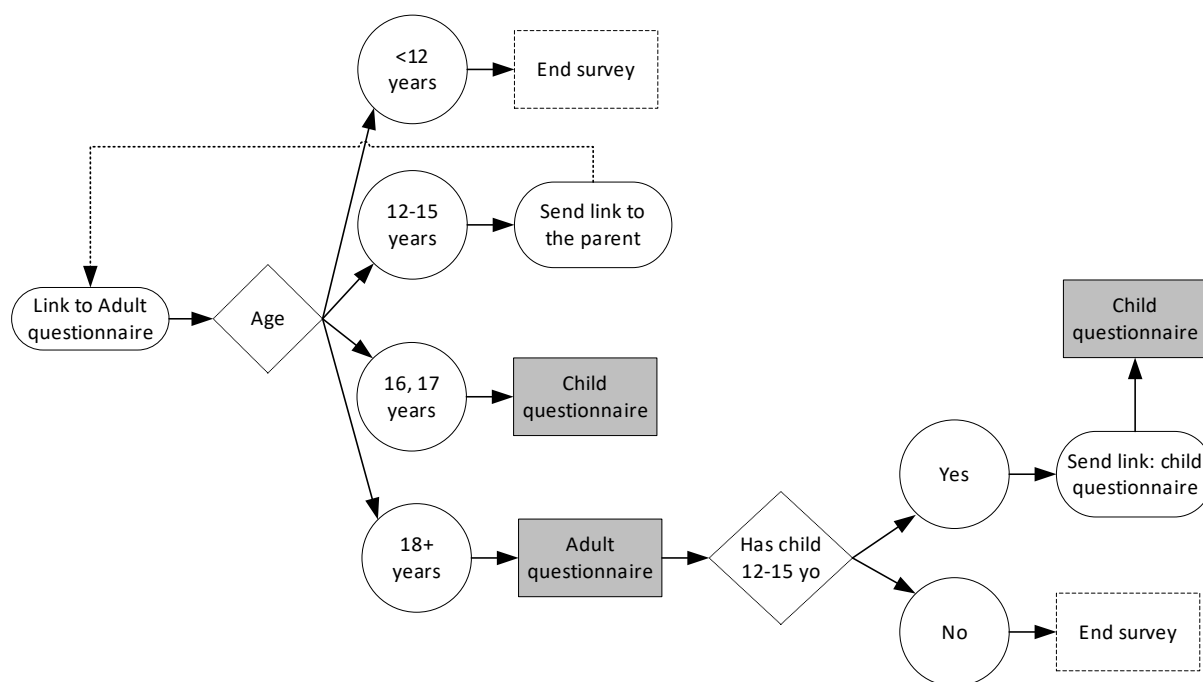

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Why did I get this survey?

At FRA we are the European Union's independent centre for promoting and protecting human rights in the EU. We regularly run surveys like this to gather information. They help make Europe a better place to live and work.

We are collecting information from children and young people like you about your situation after fleeing Ukraine. By answering the survey questions, we can understand your real-life experience. We can also help highlight the needs of your friends and family.

You got the link to this survey because your parent (or legal guardian) agreed that you can participate in this survey. Taking part in this survey is completely voluntary.

Who can take part in the survey?

You are invited to fill in this survey if you are currently staying in Bulgaria, Czechia, Estonia, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Poland, Romania, Slovakia or Spain. You have to be at least 12 years old to participate in the survey.

What is the survey about?

The survey collects information on how children and young people fleeing Ukraine feel about their lives, their rights, their living conditions, and their level of integration in their current country of residence. There are no right or wrong answers.

We are interested in your personal views, opinions, needs, and feelings whatever they are. We encourage you to freely express them and ideally to fill in this questionnaire by yourself. But if you need help for some questions, it is fine to ask someone else for support.

There should not be any harmful questions. In case something in the questionnaire upsets you, please talk to someone, for example to a friend or adult who you trust.

Why is the survey important?

The outcome of the survey will provide important information to the EU and the Member States, as well as organisations working with children and young people who are fleeing the war in Ukraine. It is necessary to collect more information so that projects and laws can be started that will help support you.

Who is doing the survey?

The EU Agency for Fundamental Rights (FRA) is carrying out the survey in 10 EU Member States. FRA is an independent public service agency of the European Union. It helps EU institutions and Member States to ensure that the fundamental rights of all people are respected and their needs addressed.

How can I complete the survey?

You can complete this survey on a desktop, laptop, tablet or smartphone by clicking on the button 'Start the survey' and following the instructions.

For each question, please choose the answer that best reflects your personal situation, feelings, or experiences. Please be aware that you do not have to answer any questions that you do not want to answer, or you do not understand.
