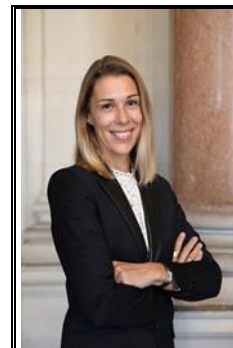

After practicing as a junior prosecutor, Florence Merloz worked for the Ministry of Justice in the field of international cooperation in criminal matters before being seconded at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as Head of the human rights division of the Legal Department (Direction des affaires juridiques) of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. As such, she represented the French government before the European Court of Human Rights (Government Agent) and the United-Nations Human Rights Committees. She was also the French representative in the steering committee for human rights (CDDH) in the Council of Europe, member of the Bureau, and chaired a working group on the place of the European Convention on Human Rights in the international and European legal order (SYSC II). She was appointed at the Court of cassation as judge referee, Head of the international relations department of the Court of cassation in January 2020.
